



Volunteers – Description of the areas of activity

Area “Race”

Do you want to take part in the Mountain Bike World Championships and witness the race live at the track?

You will care for the athletes in the start and finish areas or experience the race first-hand as a track attendant.

Area “Catering”

No worries! You don't have to work in catering directly. The job is about coordinating the different food and beverage companies. You will help us keep track.

Area “Expo, Administration, Ceremonies”

There will be a lot of activities on and around the competition area in addition to the races: a large expo-area, where one can watch and/or buy new models and clothing; a campground; as well as different side-events. The jobs range from ticket control at the entrance, assistance and coordination at the sales exhibition, hostess-service at the award ceremonies and support at side-events. A lot of work is waiting also in this area.

Area “Volunteers”

To guarantee that the event will run smoothly, it is important to care well for the many volunteers. You will help us providing them with food and beverages optimally, coordinate and organize them (who will be where when?), and provide them with information and clothing.

Area “Accreditation”

Would you like to welcome the riders, team managers and journalists to Saalfelden Leogang and provide them with any relevant information to make sure the events runs trouble-free? You will issue badges, hand over the starting documents, give any kind of information, and generally care for any needs of the international athletes as good as possible.

Area “Press, Public Relations, VIPs”

In this area you will get the unique chance to work closely with editors of renowned print media and TV stations or host our VIP guests. This makes a perfect opportunity for you to gain insight and experience concerning press and public relations.

Area “Assembly”

In order to create the infrastructure for successful world championships we have to rely on motivated volunteers. Become part of the games: Help preparing the competition tracks and hotspots for the event; Accompany the international technical delegates on their track inspections and do repair works; Build the sections for the trials together with the experts or build the fencing along the high-speed downhill track.

Area “TV”

The Mountain Bike & Trials World Championships will be broadcast live on all continents. Perfect preparation work has to be done in order to guarantee high-quality pictures. You can make a valuable contribution by accompanying and supporting an international TV production company at its work. Your job will range from building the platforms for the cameras to laying transmission links.

Area “Engineering”

This area of activity ranges from mounting a bike wash to assisting at timekeeping to installing the expo and the technical equipment in the party tent. People with technical skills or those who are willing to learn are mostly welcome.

Area “Communication”

Help us at the central information point: coordinate the workers and volunteers, provide official information and make sure we can be reached by radio or telephone at any time.

Area “Anti-Doping”

Doping is a delicate subject in sports. As interested athlete yourself you get the chance to assist at doping controls as chaperone.

You can also work in several different areas, so you get as much insight into the World Championships as possible.
